Building: ~30 units, 3 floors, 2 or 3 bedrooms. Focus on families that attend Thomas Gregg Neighborhood School: housing, employment, training programs. Currently no name for building except Moving Forward 2.0 but discussions of potentially naming it after long time near eastside resident and volunteer Ruth Shaw.
