NESCO's mission: NESCO engages Near Eastsiders to work toward the safety and betterment of neighborhoods

Shannon: Duvall Residential Facility:

- Provided overview of Community Fair that was held on August 18, 2018.
- Every weekend their crews have been volunteering at cleanups and Neighborhood projects.

Satchuel:

- Hot dog cart: Needing to locate title for license plate and she will verify that it is necessary for this type of equipment. Height adjuster needs checking out - Chris can check it out
- Hot dog cart rental: Received email from DayStar (Englewood) that they are having an event on Friday, September 21, 2018 and would like to utilize the hot dog cart. Discussions about not charging DayStar since many NESCO meetings are held at Englewood Christian Church NESCO has an old rental agreement that is available to use. Contact DayStar about them purchasing items leftover from Feast of Lanterns
Motion to permit DayStar to utilize the hot dog cart with no fee as long as they have their own transportation/hitch: Marsha. 2nd: Natalie. Unanimous vote for approval.
- Feast of Lanterns: Thunderstorms caused event to be cancelled early but still sold \$117.00 (all items \$1.00) - Marsha has the unused hotdogs and buns. Satchuel and Molly have some soft drinks, snacks, watermelons, and apples. Satchuel has receipts for \$691.16 for supplies. Satchuel will donate watermelons/apples to PourHouse.
- Potential future events for selling leftover Feast of Lanterns items: Saturdays at Duvall Residential Facility for families attending, Duvall basketball game event, Arsenal 5k, First Fridays, Cottage Home, October Trunk or Treat. etc.

Land Use Committee: Chris provided updates on rezoning variance for East Tenth Street Baptist at 3419, 3423, 3425, 3429 East 10th Street / 970 North Olney Street. Zoning Appeals Division 2 will have hearing on Tuesday, September 11, 2018 100p. Greg Dixon asking for zoning variance for men's transitional housing. Discuss conditions of building when tour was given to four community organizations (Rivoli Park Neighborhood, NEAR, John H. Boner Community Center, Englewood CDC). Chris will send email with details of Zoning Appeals meeting.

Indianapolis Neighborhood Resource Center: NESCO 1 vote for Board of INRC - Valerie is one of the candidates for a position on the INRC Board. Motion to support Valerie Davis for INRC Board of Directors position: Kevin, 2nd Shirley. Unanimous vote for approval.

IndyGo Blue Line: IndyGo requesting letter of support for Federal grant application. Discussions regarding IndyGo impact on East Washington Street, potentially naming IndyGo stops be named for NESCO Neighborhoods, impact of losing 50% of stops, IndyGo has conducted multiple project meetings in the area. Motion to provide IndyGo letter of support for Federal

grant for Blue Line: Jim Bowden, 2nd: Gabe. Unanimous vote for approval. Questions for Blue Line IndyGo project can be submitted from NESCO once consolidated.

NESCO Vice President: Mark Frisbee hasn't attended NESCO Board meetings in many months and according to the Bylaws can be removed. Motion to remove Mark Frisbee as NESCO Vice President: Chris, 2nd: Natalie. Unanimous vote for approval except for one abstention.
